“Health & Safety Code 1268.6: Commencing July 1, 1997, it shall be a requirement of initial licensure of an Intermediate Care Facility/Developmentally Disabled Habilitative or Intermediate Care Facility/Developmentally Disabled Nursing, that the applicant or designee of the applicant attend an 8-hour orientation program approved by the State Department of Developmental Services.”
